## **Program Assumptions:**

- 1. If a professional already received and completed POWER Ohio, they would not be eligible for the same level in POWER Ohio after July 1, 2022
- 2. Professionals apply when a level is completed. The first payment would be administered upon approval of the application. Level is determined by the highest education earned.
- 3. For professionals with degrees, they will receive up to 6 payments (3 years) if they remain eligible and stay employed with their program.
- 4. Level 8 and 9, availability is limited. Accept up to 50 recipients in FY23.
- 5. Eligibility
  - a. Professional works for an ODJFS licensed program with a role of Assistant Teacher, Lead Teacher or Administrator.
  - b. Professionals work directly with children birth to 5 years old at least 20 hours a week
