




- Launched in August 2022

High School Student Options




- Career Technical Students in Early Childhood Education

- Traditional High School Student




Fall Signing Day – October 5, 2022

- Date is in conjunction with World Teacher Day
- High School Students are committing to complete the 120 CDA Training hours this academic year
- Student receives a commitment certificate
- Applications are due September 30, 2022




CDA Assessment Fee & CDA Attainment

- High School Seniors who are ready to apply to the CDA Council for the credential
- Training hours may be obtained through Career Technical Education, College Credit Plus Courses or CCR&R Training
- Scholarship pays for the \$425 CDA assessment fee and provides an \$500 incentive to attain and upload their CDA credential by June 30, 2023




Spring Signing Day

- High School Senior who is committing to Early Childhood Higher Education or Early Childhood Employment
- Student receives certificate for signing day and honor cords to wear at graduation.



College Tuition Assistance

- Professionals currently working in a ODJFS licensed program and enrolled in a degree program
- Role: Assistant Teacher and Lead Teacher
- Not participating in TEACH
- Degree program is a related degree
- Up to \$5,000 per semester in tuition assistance – passing grade, school bill/proof of payment and employment verification letter
- Retention for the recipient to stay at their program




High School Students in Child Care

- CCN 8760: New Policy Lowering Minimum Age for High School Students/Graduates Working in Child Care
 - Lowers the minimum age as long as certain training occurs
 - Supervision of student is maintained by Center Administrator
 - Those that graduate under the age of 18 (Centers and Family Child Care)
- ODJFS Licensed Programs
- Currently in Clearance for public comment
