## Trauma Informed Care Certificate requirements

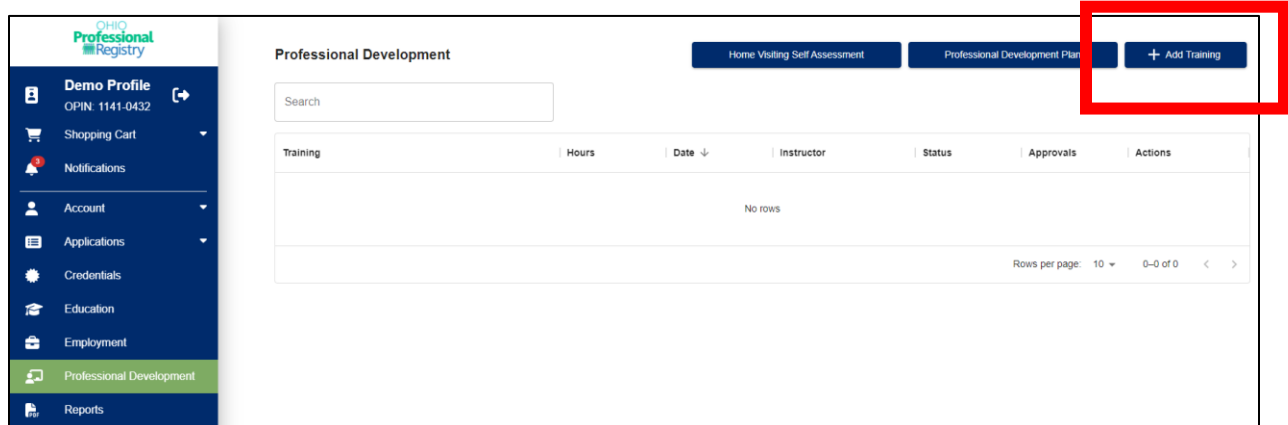
The Trauma Informed Care Certificate is based upon completion of Professional Development (PD) that meets the trauma informed competencies as determined by the Ohio Department of Job & Family Services and the Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services.

If you accessed the PD Event via a blue Access Training button via your OPR profile, attendance will be provided automatically to your profile and a certificate will not need to be uploaded.

If you have taken a PD Event outside of the OPR, you can upload the paper certificate by navigating to your OPR profile, Professional Development tab and selecting the +Add Trainings button.



## How to apply for the Trauma Informed Care Certificate

Sign in to your Ohio Professional Registry (OPR) profile. If you do not already have an OPR profile, and need assistance with creating one, view our [Create OPR Profile Resources](#) webpage for additional details. Do not create duplicate profiles.

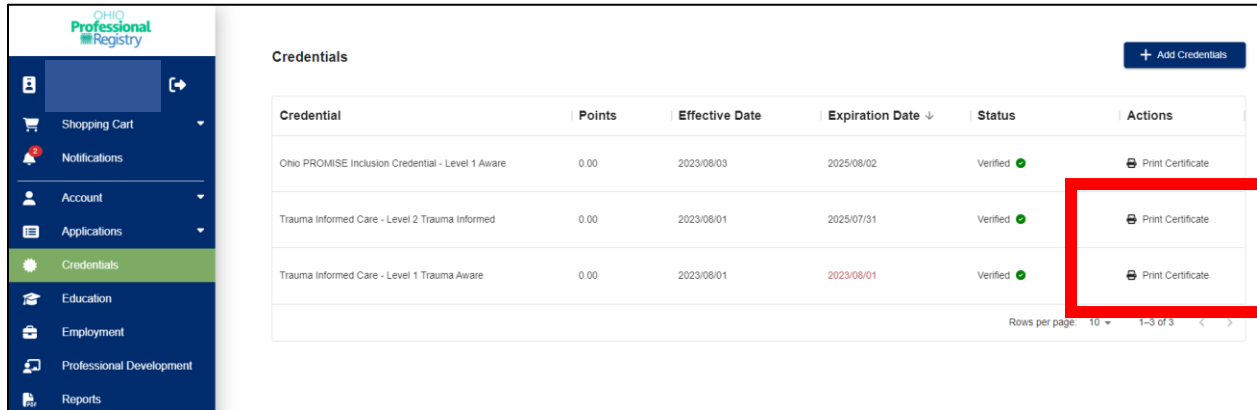
1. Navigate to the Applications section of your OPR profile and select the + button beside the Trauma Informed Care options to expand.



2. Complete the fields within the application.
3. Personal Information and Employment Information is pre-populated from your OPR profile. If applicable for TIC level 3 only, upload an official transcript with confer date to the Education tab of your OPR profile for eligibility review.
4. In the Training Information section, select the corresponding training in each competency category by hitting +Select Training. The PD Events need to be verified in the Professional Development tab for them to show up. Once you select the PD Event, you cannot select it again.
5. Once you have selected the required amount of PD hours and at least one PD Event for each competency, the Submit Application button will turn green and allow submission.
6. Your application will be reviewed and processed by the OPR staff within 30 business days of submission.
7. The OPR provides notifications to you within your profile. You will be informed of any action taken on an application. You will find the notifications by the flag next to your name. In addition, you will receive an e-mail if there are any new notifications in your profile.

### Approved Certificate Application

Upon approval of an application, a Trauma Informed Care Certificate record and certificate for the Level you applied for, will be available in the Credentials tab in your OPR Profile. A printable certificate is available for download for your personal records.
