

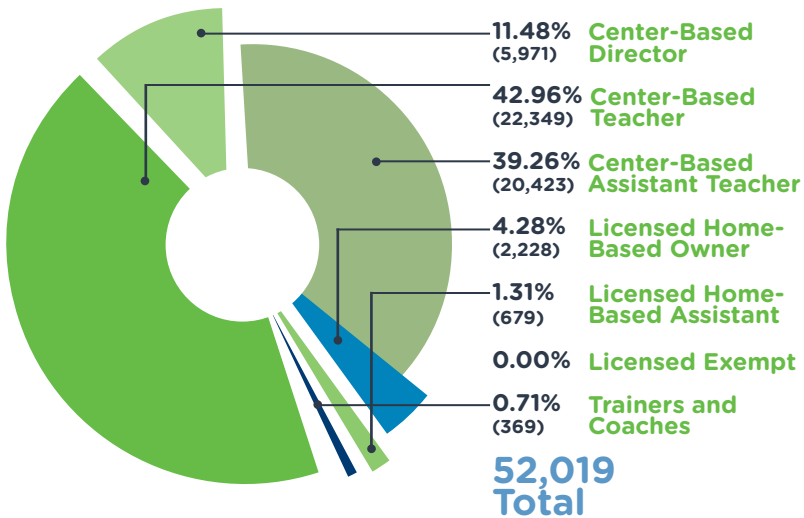

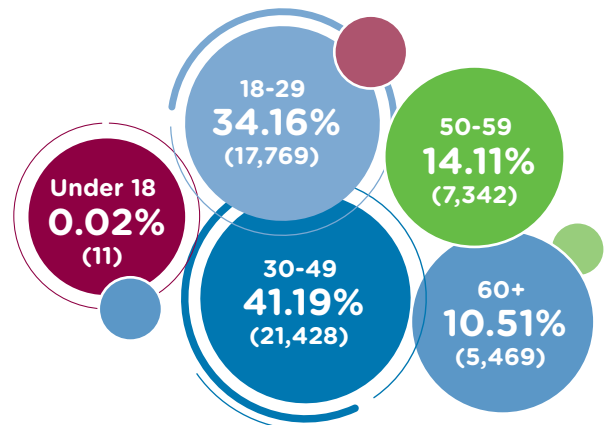

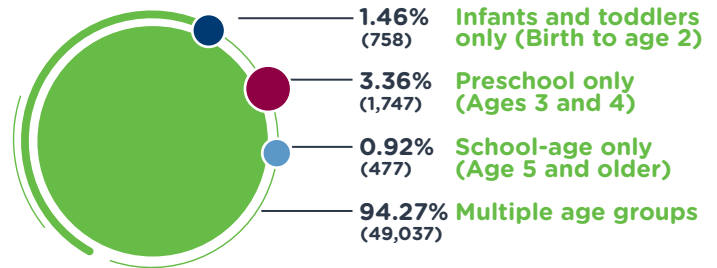

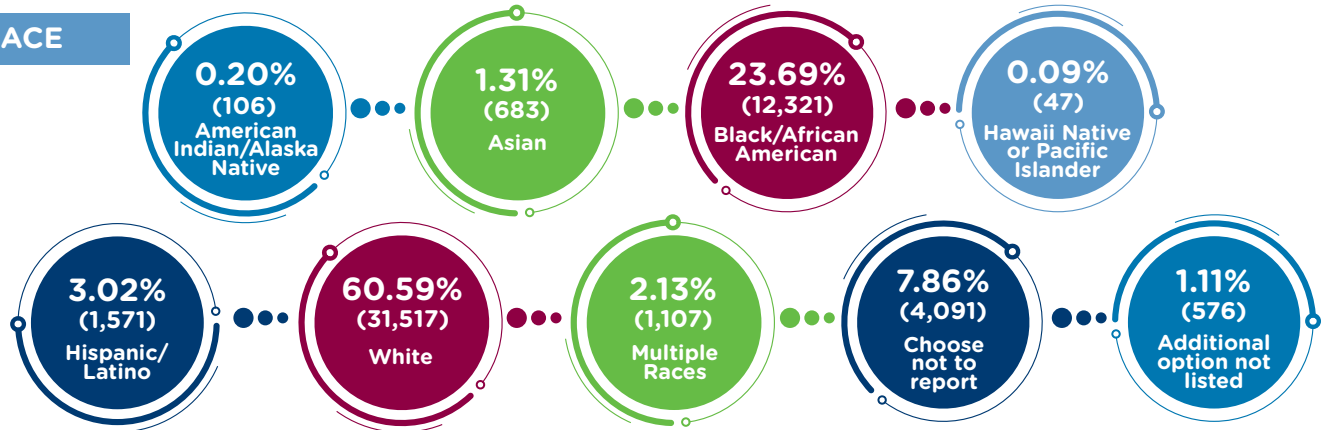

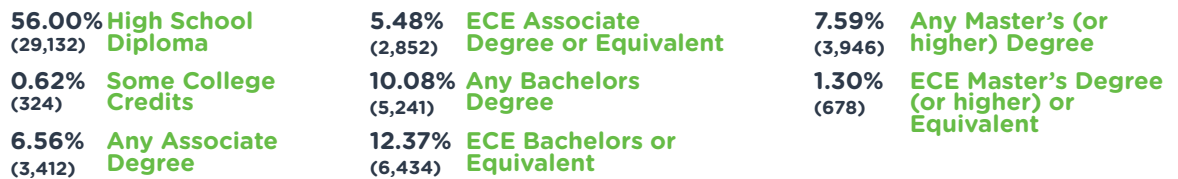
4 WORKFORCE BY AGES SERVED

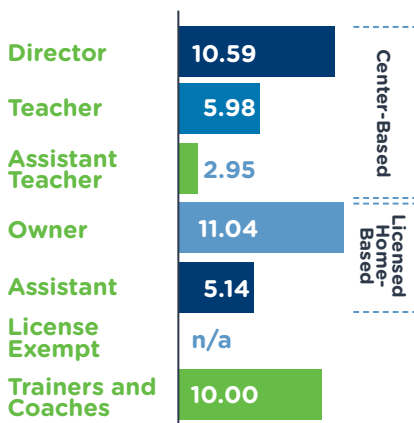

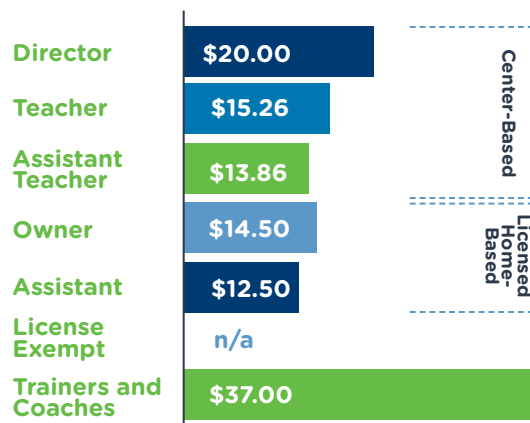
