Who needs a PD Certificate?

- Must be working in a SUTQ rated program
- Must be in a qualifying role: Administrator, Lead Teacher, Assistant Teacher

How many hours do I need?

The number of hours will vary depending on when you were hired or when the program became rated. This number is prorated based on your hire date and/or the program’s rating date. The PD Certificate flowchart below can help to determine PD hours needed.

How do I achieve a PD Certificate?

There are 3 components to the PD Certificate:

1. Complete the *Ohio’s Approach to Quality* training
2. Complete the *Ohio’s Overview of Child Development* training
3. Complete the required number of Ohio Approved (OA) hours.
