

## **Ohio PROMISE Professional Credential (OPPC) Requirements**

## Level 3 Advanced - Learning Path

To obtain the OPPC Level 3 Credential, each professional must have met, applied, and been awarded OPPC Level 1 and Level 2.

## **AND**

Complete the following five (5) professional development sessions available in the Ohio Professional Registry for a total of 7.5 hours of Ohio Approved training:
