What are ITAGs and CTAGs?

ITAGs are a state transfer initiative that guarantees college credit to individuals who have earn an industry-recognized credential.

CTAGs are a state transfer initiative that guarantees college credit to individuals who have completed approved high school CTE courses.

- Certifications and high school standards are aligned to college coursework by faculty and are endorsed by the state.
- Students can receive college credit at any of Ohio's 35 public colleges or universities offering similar courses.


